

Instances of Jesus at table recorded only in Luke's Gospel

- In the house of Simon the Pharisee and receiving the "woman . . . which was a sinner" (7:36-50)
- At the house of Martha and Mary (10:38-42)
- With "a certain Pharisee" and denouncing the Pharisees (11:37-54)
- With "one of the chief Pharisees" on the sabbath and healing a man with dropsy (14:1-24)
- With Zacchæus (19:5,6)
- With two disciples at Emmaus (24:28-31).
